STATE FUNDED ACT

All Juniors will be taking the ACT at Anderson High School on February 25th. This includes students who attend the Oaks and students who are enrolled in CCP courses. Students must be in their testing location no later than 8AM. Testing locations will be posted on Schoology. Juniors can begin to arrive at their testing location at 7:30AM. Testing will start first thing in the morning and

conclude around noon. Students testing, should bring extra pencils, their own calculator and a snack for their break. Junior students will be dismissed after testing. There will be no bussing until the normal building dismissal time. All Juniors who stay after testing has concluded, will follow their normal daily schedule. All other students will attend school as normal on this day. Makeup testing will be communicated to those students who are not present on the 25th.

Dart Wars

Over the last several years, many students at schools across SW Ohio have participated in a game called Dart Wars. FHSD wants to make sure that the parent community understands this is NOT a school-sponsored or supported activity. *The game is not allowed to be played on any district property and it is not allowed to interfere with learning during the school day.* This includes communication that is verbal or through social media that could interfere with the educational environment.

We encourage families to speak with their students about this activity and consider the potential risks associated with a game like this being played in different parts of our community. Again, the district does not support or encourage this game to be played, and it is prohibited from school campuses for safety concerns. We are sharing this information with families because spring is the time of year when the activity typically occurs.
