

Bullying and Other Forms of Aggressive Behavior (NEOLA 5517.01 Student Conduct)

The Forest Hills School District Board of Education is committed to providing a safe, positive, productive, and nurturing educational environment for all of its students. The Board encourages the promotion of positive interpersonal relations between members of the school community.

As part of the requirements prescribed in R.C. 3313.66 and the development of the Board's policy, building administrators from each school building shall provide the Superintendent with a written summary of all substantiated incidents of harassment, intimidation, or bullying. In addition, this summary is provided to the Board President and posted on the District website two times annually (January 31 and June 30).
