WEB {Where Everybody Belongs} is a middle school orientation and transition program that makes our 7th graders feel more comfortable and confident throughout the first year of their middle school experience. Built on the belief that students can help students succeed, the WEB program trains mentors from our 8th grade class to be WEB Leaders. The first step in the WEB experience is 7TH GRADE WEB ORIENTATION.

WHAT TO EXPECT ON ORIENTATION DAY?

7th graders will be greeted by their WEB leaders. They will participate in small group and large group activities with other classmates in their house. Students will have fun getting to meet new people and find friendly faces. 7th graders also receive their schedules and will take a guided tour of the building and have the opportunity to practice opening their locker.

If your student has specific medical needs, the school nurse will be on campus for both WEB Orientation days.

HOW DO WE KNOW WHICH DAY TO ATTEND?

Your student will receive an email from Nagel Middle School the first week of June that will tell them (and you!) which Orientation Day your 7th grader should attend. If your student is attending on August 15, they are on House 2: Team 2A or Team 2B. If they are attending on August 16, they are on House 1: Team 1A, Team 1B, or Team 1C. They will meet students that will be in the same lunchtime each day. On the orientation day, your student will find out their team and their Encore classes.

Students must wear comfortable clothes and tennis/gym shoes and not bring any additional items with them. All materials will be provided.
