

Sherwood Remote Learning Dec. 14th-18th

Good Afternoon Archer Families!

Due to the high number of COVID related absences in over one-third of our staff and a significant number of students at Sherwood, we will be shifting to remote learning for all students beginning tomorrow, Monday, December 14th through the 18th. Please keep in mind that this pertains to only Sherwood Elementary. The impact that these absences have had and will continue to have on our ability to provide in-person learning safely across all grade levels led us to take this course of action at this time.

For Monday, December 14th, learning will be self-directed for all students as teachers utilize this day to prepare materials for remote learning on Tuesday the 15th through Friday the 18th. We also understand that students will be without devices on Monday. A device pick-up option will be available on Monday from 4pm-8pm at the Sherwood gym entrance (similar to end of the year pick-up last May). More details will follow in regards to specifics for device/material pick-up. If these times don't work for your family, please contact the office at 231-7565 and we will work with you to make sure you have the needed materials.

I understand the challenges this decision places upon families for the upcoming week. I also know that safety is of the utmost importance to all of you during these unprecedented times. We appreciate your understanding and support as we transition into remote learning over the next 48 hours.
